Walk Safely

-  Teach children to make eye contact with drivers before crossing in front of them.
-  Always walk on sidewalks or paths. If there are no sidewalks, walk facing traffic as far to the left as possible.
-  Children should walk on direct routes with the fewest street crossings.
-  Watch for cars that are turning or backing up. Teach children to never dart out into the street or cross between parked cars.

Trick or Treat With an Adult

Children under the age of 12 should not be alone at night without adult supervision. If kids are mature enough to be out without supervision, they should stick to familiar areas that are well lit and trick-or-treat in groups.

Drive Extra Safely on Halloween

-  Slow down and be especially alert in residential neighborhoods. Children are excited on Halloween and may move in unpredictable ways.
-  Take extra time to look for kids at intersections, on medians and on curbs.
-  Enter and exit driveways and alleys slowly and carefully.
-  Drive slowly, anticipate heavy pedestrian traffic and turn your headlights on earlier in the day to spot children from greater distances.

Lawn Care Reminders

The burning of leaves, yard waste and newspapers is permitted 6:00 a.m.— 8:00 p.m.

Monday—Saturday and must be extinguished by 8:00 p.m. with no smoldering.

Please do not burn on any township road, right-of-way or ditch line.

A competent adult and adequate water source must be present.

No burning on legal holidays or Sundays.

Exceptions are cooking and recreational fires.

Prior to burning large brush piles, contact the township and non-emergency 911 center.

Please do not cause a safety issue by blowing lawn trimmings onto the road.

Winter Reminders

Snow Removal

To prevent a hazard, do not push snow onto the road.

Parking

It is unlawful to park on township roads. Cars must be eight feet from the road in order for the road department to remove snow to the edge of the pavement. Violators may be cited.

Mailboxes

The township is not responsible for damage to mailboxes that are in the township's right-of-way. Mailbox post must be behind the ditch line and the minimum of two feet off the road. To avoid problems, please place the mailboxes as far off the road as possible yet still permitting access for mail carriers.
